



ALAN THOMAS GRADUATE STUDENT PAPER AWARD 2024

All graduate students with accepted full paper proposals for the 2024 Canadian Association for the Study of Adult Education (CASAE) conference are invited to submit their full proceedings paper for consideration for the Alan Thomas Graduate Student Paper Award. The winner of the Award will be announced at the CASAE Annual General Meeting during the 2024 conference. The Award is accompanied by a modest payment and a certificate.

Dr. Alan Thomas was Professor of Adult Education at the Ontario Institute for Studies in Education at the University of Toronto, former Executive Director of the Canadian Association for Adult Education and a founding director of the Carold Institute. This award recognizes Alan's contribution to the field but also his commitment and dedication to students.

Criteria: You must be a graduate students at the time of writing the paper and you must also be sole author or co-author with another graduate student. Your supervisor or one of your instructors cannot be included as a co-author on your paper. Papers must be full papers; roundtable and symposium papers are not eligible.

Adjudication: Papers will be adjudicated by a team of CASAE members, including members of the Executive.

Submission Process:

1. One copy of your full proceedings paper including full contact details on both the paper and in the email accompanying your submission.
